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The School Context

GVHSS for Girls is located in the Nadakkavu area of Kozhikode district in Kerala. The school is situated in an urban area and managed by the Department of Education. It is a Co-educational school.

Challenges faced due to School Closure

GVHS School faced many challenges during school closure such as the communication gap between teachers and students, non-availability of internet services. Due to the poor financial background of students, students lacked the availability of technological devices such as laptops, smart phones and tabs, etc for online classes. As there is the unavailability of public transport, food and other essentials were not properly available to students during the Covid.

Innovative Leadership Practices for mitigating learning gaps

There were certain initiatives like Recording studio (MLA fund - 12 Lakhs), Atal Tinkering Lab (ATL) Practical Demonstration videos, She Camp, Memory Master 2020, A survey in Covid, and lifestyle changes. AKAM' online youth Festival, Happy Learnings, Career Planning, WhatsApp Groups were formed for all classes. Peer group formation with a teacher in charge - follow-ups for students. Special timetable for the discussion of the Victers Channel, Conducting online examination, School Health Inspection Team - Action plan.
