# THE BRIEF HISTORY ABOUT GOVERNMENT HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOL, LHOU

## (SINCE 1964 TO 2018)

The Lhou Junior-based School first started with 20 students on 31<sup>st</sup> March 1964 along with the PO Tawang under NEFA and other official of Government, village heads, villagers who were there for opening ceremony. The school started with Shri Pandey as the teacher I/C. The school was established on 31<sup>st</sup> March 1964 on a donated land, a small hut, no proper facilities and with only one teacher. At first there was no arrangement of free lodging & free food. The school was frequently visited by the government official and one of the official Mr. P.C.Prasad (IPS) on 23.06.1964 promised that on coming day in due course administration is going to make this school furnished with free food and free lodging. On 30.06.1964 Mr. O.P.Gupta (Base Supt.(Den)/BDO) visited the school garden was coming up nicely and it was expected that some portion of the mid – day meal would be made available from the garden. He also promised Shri Pandey, Teacher I/C of some soap and Mustard oil for students better health and hygiene. Again on 14<sup>th</sup> December 1964 a school building was constructed by self-help by Lhou villagers.

During the year of 1964, Lhou was one of the biggest villages in Tawang District under which there was 15 villages and a population of about 500 approx. with age group of

0-4 = 40 5-14=55 15-30 = 90 30-50=95 60-100=120 Approx.

The School was upgraded to Secondary level on 29<sup>th</sup> May 1986. The gazette Headmaster was Mr. B.N. Pandey then after Mr. B. N. Pandey; Mr. S.N.Iswar was the gazette Headmaster.

The school infrastructure was S.P.Type then the maintenance of the school continued. As we have known the earlier school infrastructure was made of planks, mud and clay daub. There were no proper classrooms, Teachers Quarter, no science laboratory, separate library and sanitation facility.

Over the years it has undergone many changes as now we have a RCC infrastructure. In recent years our Principal Mr. Norbu Tashi made a number of important changes to the building and the classrooms are fit for 21<sup>st</sup> century education. The classrooms are modernized with a huge range of teaching resources and facilities at our disposal. Our Headmaster Mr. Norbu Tashi has taken special pain and a very beautiful library that is of a local art and architecture look outside but the inside of the library is fit for 21<sup>st</sup> century, He has dreamt many good things for the school as the leader of the school and the dream is gradually taking shape. Now under his leadership, we have a separate school auditorium, a science laboratory fully equipped, a library, art and craft room, proper sanitation for both girls and boys and presently a hostel building is under constructed under his supervision. During his time our school was awarded as the best school in Arunachal twice at a

straight. We often wonder what some of the older generations of pupils would think if they were able to visit us now......



#### **OUR SCHOOL NOW:-**

We are a one form-entry school consisting of KG to class XII (Twelve). We have a large school building. And many other separate building for other school activities. The school also have a computer hall and a smart classroom where when needed the teacher use it during their teaching.

We also encourage our pupils to cooperate instead of competing each other. Secularism is given utmost importance. Brotherhood is taught along with respecting each other. The social and moral values are given the utmost importance here. Counseling is often done by the people visiting our school. Moral and social values are imparted by our respected Headmaster on daily basis.

For physical education and activities, we use multi games available in our school along with our large playground, where our pupils are encouraged to explore and play throughout the day here the students are advised to respect all religions and so we celebrate almost all the festivals with gaiety.

The teachers here take the pain to visit home of their students and communicate with their parents.



#### **THE MOTTO OF SCHOOL KITCHEN GARDEN:-**

Our school also have a kitchen garden which is fully organic. Here the students are trained to use compost instead of using a chemical fertilizers. Gardening is done on weekly basis. Children are advised by our respected Principal and teacher in charge of MDM to clean their respective village as well. Relation between the taught (student) and teachers are being strengthened. From our kitchen garden we procure lots of vegetables like Pumpkin, Potato, Beans, Squash, Radish, Carrot, Cucumber and many more.



#### AIMS :-

The primary aim of the school is to prepare students academically, physically and psychologically for their better future. The all-around education of the School, however, fully equips a student to pursue any other career with distinction. A sound character, esprit de corps, dedication, patriotic outlook and desire to serve the country are the qualities which Government Secondary School seeks to promote.

A large number of activities, such as debates, school level and district level science seminar, science seminar, science exhibition, science congress, essay competition, art competition, extempore speech competition, cultural competition etc. are held regularly throughout the year. Students are encouraged to participate in inter house as well as in inter school competition and contest both at block and district level.

- a) Academics: Debate, Recitation, Painting, Essay writing, Story Writing, Science Seminar.
- b) Games & Sports: Football, Volleyball, Basketball, Cricket, Athletics, etc.
   Representation:- Our students participate in various Academic competitions and Games & Sports tournaments all over the state. Efforts are made to send students for excursions Educational Tours to important places.





## **SCOUT AND GUIDE:-**

By virtue of gaining admission to G.H. S. S. Lhou every student automatically becomes a member of Scout and Guide and has to take part in parades and other scout and guide activities and various courses at various places in India. Various activities are conducted to train and award certificates to the students.

- a) Independence Day Parade.
- b) Republic Day Parade.
- c) Cub/Bulbul Utsav.
- d) Raj Puraskar Testing Camp.



## **MDM**

The Mid – Day Meal programme has been running very nicely at our school. We have prepared a menu on the other hand we have taken healthy and safety measures in preparing food. Before serving ther meal the incharge taste the meal.







## **SOCIAL SERVICE**

Social Service at school is necessary to bring a social responsibility and social consciousness among the students. Besides the daily cleanliness at our school our schools takes some programme on social service. Both the teachers and students take parts on this service specially this service is done in public places like bazaar, gonpas and at villages.





## **SCIENCE LABORATORY:-**

Our Science laboratory is not well equipped with all the facilities necessary for experiments but it is the centre of creativity and innovation as students from different classes apply their scientific concepts to construct new things and do activities with whatever little equipment we have. It is advantageous for us that our school surroundings has varieties of trees which sometimes helps us in many biological experiments.







## **GAMES & SPORTS:-**

We believe in the principle of "The sound body has a sound mind" games & sports are the important part of our curriculum. We organize interhouse sports competition in every last three days of the month where students participate in different sports such as Football, Volley ball, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Archery etc. and we believe that these activities refreshes the minds of the students.







## LIBRARY:-

Library is the house of knowledge. It is the place where students not only acquire bookish knowledge but also of the outsider world. It helps the students to improve learning abilities but also make them with a habit of learning. Library encourage the students participation in teaching learning process.







## **SWACHCHTA:-**

"Health is Wealth" it is a proverb which emphasis on better health. It lead a overall growth of the individual. Our school gives major importance on cleanliness. On the birth anniversary of "Mahatma Gandhi" we celebrate his birthday as a social service to our local community, Students are eagerly participating and villagers also cooperate to clean their surroundings.









## **EXAMINATION:-**

It is a yearly Evaluation of the students that how much learning takes place during the session. Examination are conducted on the basis of fair evaluation so that examiner know the students learning outcomes.



#### **UNIFORM:**

School Uniform makes the school environment under the shadow of discipline and punctuality. It enhance or motivate children to come to school. It discourage the discrimination among the students on which the background of their family belong.







## **COURSE COMPLETION:-**

Scheme books, log books and teachers' diary are maintained by the teachers in completion of courses. Remedial classes are conducted by the subject teachers . In the end of December month revision of courses are done. Every week of the month class test are conducted for the academic evaluation.


#### **THE SCHOOL MUSEUM :-**

#### LEARNING FROM THE PAST

The school museum plays a crucial role in teaching the students and its visitors the past monpa local culture. The artifacts preserved in it are objects used by our ancestors and materials of religious, cultural and historical value. It educates the students to look into the past aswell as the future, to see where we've been and where we might go. The artifacts collected here are mostly of Monpa community which convey us a picture of past monpa tribe which we have not seen before. Most of the artifacts are rare and very old which were used by the earlier owners and then mostly discarded away. With the presence of our school museum our past civilization (Monpa Tribe) cannot be forgotten by the new generation, as it represents the living memory of peoples. It educated the students and help them in their upbringing.







## **NATIONAL CADET CORPS(NCC):-**

The National Cadet Corps in India is a voluntary organization which recruits cadets from high schools, colleges and universities all over India. The Cadets are given basic military training in small arms and parades.

Our school had its first batch of its NCC cadets on 2019 with 29 Students . These NCC Cadets had the opportunity to participate in camp training and small arms training and parades.

The NCC also helds an yearly examination to evaluate the students and provides them with a certificate. The NCC provides opportunity to the students for their all round development with a sense of duty, commitment, dedication, discipline and moral values so that they can become able leaders and useful citizens.



### STUDENTS PARTICIPATION IN SCHOOL AFFAIRS:-

Students participate effectively in the management of their Houses, Games & Sports, Cultural activities, Literary activities, Gardening. The suggestions made by the cadets are given due consideration by the school authorities. Students from senior classes are given school appointments to exercise their organizing ability and develop qualities of leadership.

Each house has a House Master attached to it to assist the students in the studies and other activities. The House Masters guide the Students.

- If you have 'suicidal tendency'.
- If you have inferiority complex.
- If you feel rejection and failure.
- If you have waywardness.
- If you have not set your goals.
- If you have lack of information and vision.

Recite: - Stop reading periodically to recall what you have read and the chances are that you will remember more.

Review: - Go over the notes you have taken to help classify points you don't Understand and measure what you have gained from the process.
