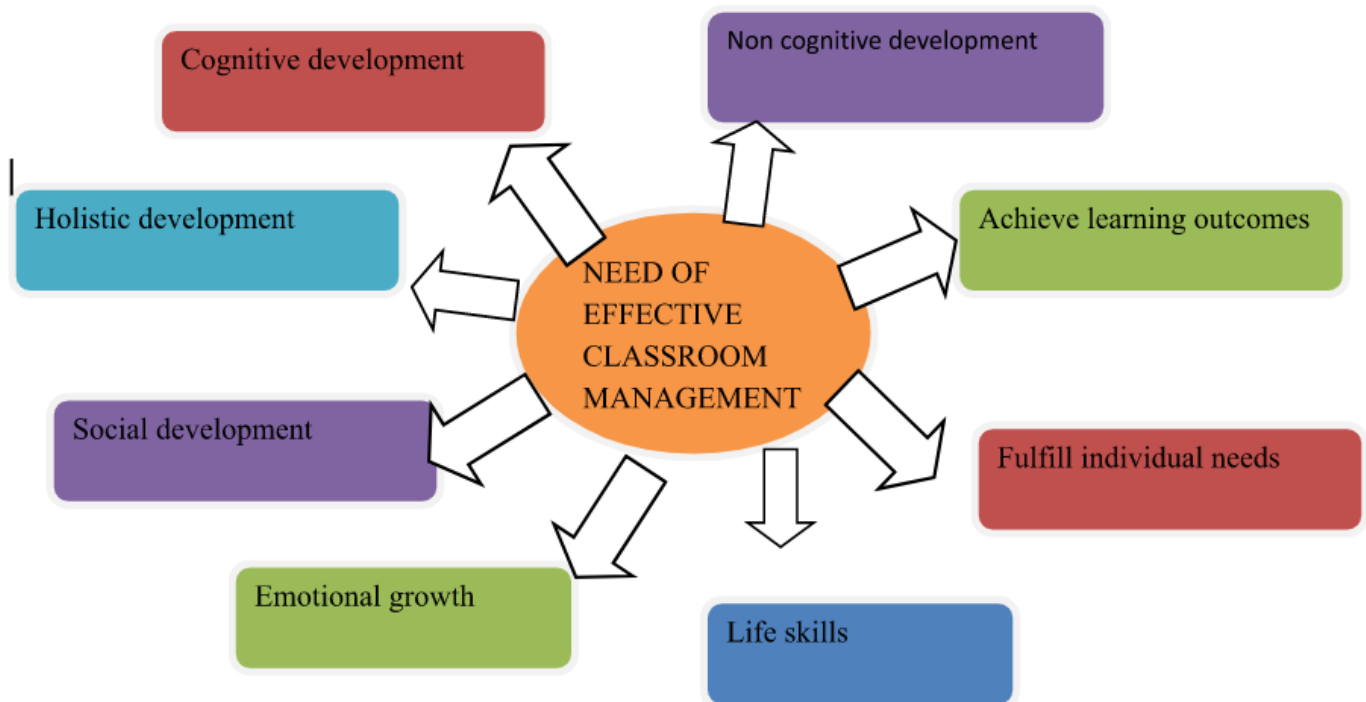

### NEED OF EFFECTIVE CLASSROOM MANAGEMENT

Effective classroom management is important for both teacher and students. It is a place where student teacher interaction takes place. Every child should get opportunity to express themselves. Effective classroom should inculcate all life skills needed for the better citizen of country



### PHYSICAL SET- UP OF AN EFFECTIVE CLASSROOM

A well managed classroom will give pupil rich opportunities for mental growth and development. Progressive education is concerned with providing every pupil with the facilities that encourage learning and open avenues for it.

- **Dimension-** The dimension of a classroom depends upon the number of classroom to be seated. The classroom should always be constructed of standard size. The classroom should be sufficient airy, there should be provision for sufficient light.
- **Furniture-** Comfortable furniture with drawer where students can keep their books.
- **Seating arrangement-** Consideration should be given to those with physical defects or needs that warrant special attention. Hearing or visual challenged pupil should be seated in front row.
- **Equipment-** Judicious use of chalkboard, charts, flannel board, pictures, slides, computers and overhead projector are desirable. It depends on competence of school head how he/she checks that these are fully utilized by the staff.
- **Resources-** The effectiveness of teaching largely depends on his knowledge, skills, exposure and competencies. A teacher should keep his knowledge updated.
- **Lesson plan-** It plays major role in teaching before teacher prepare lesson plan that includes learning objectives, teaching aids, methodology, activity, class work and home work to be given.

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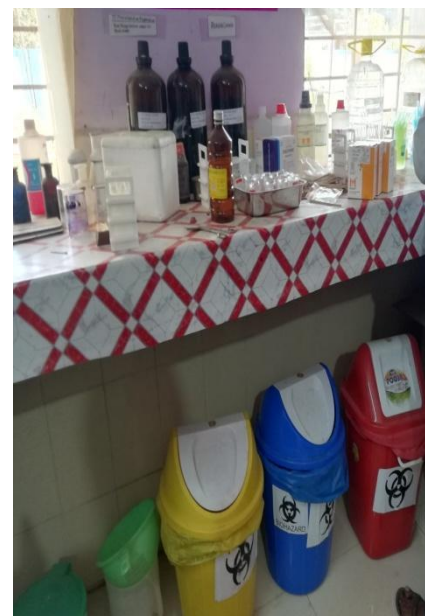
