## MEDIUM-TERM GOALS 2025-2028

- 3. Capacitate school administrators at the district/block/cluster level.

## SHORT-TERM GOALS 2025-2026

### Laying the Foundation for MSLA

- 2. Train 2000 school leaders through in-person workshops & online certificate courses.
- 3. Establish MSLA's core institutional partnerships (ASU, UoS, NCERT, NIEPA, IIM, TISS, NGOs).
- 4. Conduct baseline research on school leadership in Meghalaya.
- 5. Pilot leadership mentoring & coaching programs.

#### Short-Term (2025-2026)

#### Medium-Term (2025-2028)

- Launch a state-wide digital resource hub.

#### Long-Term (2025-2030)

- Establish a multi-level leadership certification programme.
- Launch specialized training for school leaders from educationally backward pockets.

### Long-Term (2025-2030)

Train all government school leaders across all districts.
