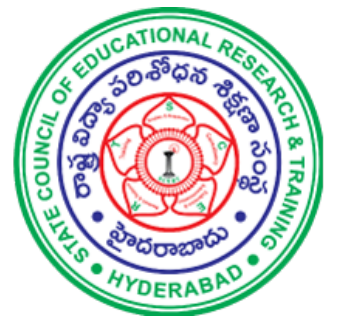




PERSPECTIVE PLANNING OF SLA-TELANGANA

- Developing new generation of School leaders to lead the Schools with futuristic thoughts and empowered school heads to administer the schools on par with global standards.

SHORT TERM GOALS

- ▶ **IMPLEMENTING HOLISTIC CURRICULUM AND WORKING OUT THE STRATEGIES FOR IMPROVED ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE.**
- ▶ **EMPOWERING THE SCHOOL LEADERS WITH NECESSARY STRATEGIES AND SKILLS TO IMPLEMENT HOLISTIC CURRICULUM AND FOR IMPROVING ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE**

Modules and material development

- **Developing Need Based Material through small survey:**
Inviting the School Heads to list out their needs and the support they require for effective functioning of Schools.
- **Prioritizing the topics in a phased manner (Different themes like Skills/Vocational, Pedagogical issues, Equity and Inclusion, Tribal Areas, gender, Pre-School/Foundational literacy; Green School, SCHOOL VALUES and ETHOS**
- **Identifying the Panel of Experts and Practitioners on the listed Topics from different Institutions in the State working on school leadership and School Heads and administrators.**

- Exploring the possibility of developing the material in a group (co-authors)
- Study of different designs of the Material/Module.
- Conduct the brainstorming sessions for the identified authors in groups for Content analysis, Methodology, layout, Illustrations, review of the literature and work distribution.

Dissemination of Learning resources prepared by SLA

- Uploading in the official website of SCERT and NCSL
- Posting the materials and weblinks of the materials through social media
- Organization of talks on the materials developed through Education channel (TSAT) and through webinars.
- Official release of materials through webinars.
- Holding reviews on the materials developed through online and offline at various levels school complex level and at district level.
- Expanding the presence on Social media platforms for effective communication about all the activities of SLA.
- Initiating the use of social media network at district level to showcase the innovations of the schools

Development of Videos showcasing

- Pedagogical Innovations

- Students Well-being, Happiness, engagement.
- To start a Weekly bulletin on YouTube channel showcasing all the small efforts made by School heads/teachers in that week

Development of Videos

- Face to face / online Training to the Heads of the Schools who are doing innovations to develop the videos : Script, story board, handling of camera, video shoot, video editing (software).
- Encouraging the Schools who are known for best practices and innovations to start youtube channel and use other social networks (Already few schools are having the youtube channels).

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Celebration of Leadership Practices AT DIFFERENT LEVELS

- Holding Consultative Meets as an Platform for Sharing of success stories at different levels School complex, at district level by DIETs and at the State level.
- Use of local media in the districts to disseminate the School Success stories
- Sharing of Success stories of the School, its media coverage among the parents and local community.
- Development of Success stories *from School complex, block level and at District Level*
- *Organization of State level seminar on School Leadership*

CONTINUOUS PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Creating awareness on CPD and how to go about it for School Leaders and system officials through online.
- Developing the capacities to the School Heads to evolve different strategies for implementing the CPD at the school level and at the school complex level.
- Based on the Studies on assessment of needs, developmental programs will be designed to all the school heads in blended mode.
- A two tier structure may be evolved to organize these developmental programs at State and at District level and later at the school complex level.
- Customized Developmental programs for the Systemic Personnel (School Complex, MEOs/BEOs, District Level Officials including DEOs.

Continuous professional development

- Capacity building of core group members of SLA and District wings of SLAs
- Evolving Learning Circles at different levels (School, Cluster, Mandal/Block and District Levels.
- Tagging SRGs, **DRGs/District wings of SLA** and School Complex HMs to the School heads for mentoring.
- Exploring the possibility of collaborating with Universities, Management Schools, Teacher Education Institutions as Knowledge Partners.
- Provisioning School Administration/ Leadership as a part of Internship of the Teacher Trainees.

Networking and Institutional Building

- Building a network of Knowledge partnership with Stake holders within(SCERT, DIETs, CTEs, DEOs, School Complex) and outside the system.
- Collaborating With institutes like CBSE and Corporate International Schools for sharing and understanding best practices.
- Making DIETs, CTEs and other Teacher Education Institutes as "Anchor Institutions" at District Level to take forward Leadership Programs.
- Collaboration with NGOs for Technical and Logistic Support who are working on School Leadership Activities.
- Roles of District wings of SLA and SLA core groups to be defined.
- Evolving non-negotiables to be followed by every school eg. Vision and Mission; Policy of School safety and Security; ICT policy; professional development; Accountability and Transparency.....

Research and development

- Recommending University (Ph.D, MEd) students to include School Leadership as one of the Research Areas for their thesis /Dissertations.
- Inclusion of School Leadership in the curriculum of Teacher Education programmes
- Promote Action Research by School Heads for school improvement as a part of CPD
- Consultative meets with Institutions on tie up with schools for mentoring School Heads.
- Conduct of Studies by SLA at-least one per year on School Leadership.
- Exploring potential areas of School Leadership in Association with other institutes.
- Sharing Research findings with with partner institutions.
